How do I get there?

From Route 128 take Route 109 towards Westwood exit 16B. Follow Route 109 West to your fourth right onto Dover Road. Take the third right off Dover Road onto Carby Street. For drop off please continue down Carby Street about 1.6 miles to the Powissett Parking area.

Hale Reservation is a private, non-profit educational organization that manages over 1,100 acres of woodlands, including four ponds and over twenty miles of trails in Westwood and Dover, Massachusetts. Hale is most widely recognized for its summer day camp programs which annually serve over 3,400 children from 65 communities in the Greater Boston area. The Reservation also offers a family program, outdoor and environmental education experiences for children and adults, and open space for casual recreational use.

The essence of Hale Reservation can be found in Robert Sever Hale's original desire for the organization he founded in 1918. The current programs and land management practices are the legacy of his wish "to provide education which will develop intelligent, capable and responsible citizens" and to use the land "so long as it is charitable and benevolent in nature." The goal of today's programs is to develop intelligent leaders and environmentally educated citizens. We believe that the diversity of the natural environment must be reflected back in the diversity of the people who experience Hale Reservation, and we strive to provide programs and opportunities for people of any race, background, religion or economic status.

Enviro-mania (Pre-K to 2nd graders)

Pre-K to 2nd graders can join the multi-talented and experienced staff at Hale Reservation for exciting indoor and outdoor nature exploration. Children will learn about animals, their habitats and habits, and do some tracking. They will also look for signs of spring. Along with nature exploration each day, the kids will play games and sports, do arts and crafts and try out a few science experiments.



Spring Adventure (3rd to 6th graders)

The focus is on outdoor adventure, teambuilding and learning about the natural world around them. Activities include: ropes course elements and rock climbing, trail hiking and GPS exploration, fishing and nature exploration, mountain biking (for those with bikes) and field games. We will have a different set of activities each day so kids can sign up for one day or all 3 days.



Who are the staff? The core staff for the Vacation Programs include Adrienne Farfalla (Education Coordinator) and James Reinhold (Camp Director). Other leaders are carefully chosen for their experience with children.
